#### Food, drink and life at The Ship

In the summer, it's about outside drinks, barbecues and beach cricket during the day, and lovely dinners of fabulous fresh seafood, meat, veggies and fruit by night. In the winter, it's about crackling log fires, staying inside out of the cold, and maybe tapping your feet to some local live music.

Whatever the season, and whatever your age, you'll probably do it with a glass in your hand. In the summer it's **rosé wine, Pimm's and crisp ales**. In the winter it's **delicious red wines, warming malt whiskies and tasty local beers**. There are always plenty of **non-alcoholic options** – or even our own fabulous teas. Hopefully this drinks list gives you a few ideas.

Our main passion is **wine**. We have been lucky enough to travel to many of the world's great wine regions, we have met the growers and the winemakers, picked the grapes, and experienced the often amazing places in which wine grapes are grown. Among others, this list contains wines from New Zealand, South Africa, France, Portgual and Spain where we have been lucky enough to meet the team out there and taste the grapes. We encourage you to drink great wine to match the fantastic surroundings, so those who know, know to go to the slightly higher-priced wines on the list which offer the best value of all. By all means do ask for the **Captain's Selection** if you want something out of the ordinary, often in a larger format.

Cocktails are an increasing part of our offering, and we have an ever-changing list combining the classics with drinks that are bang on-trend. We would like to highlight Gordon the barman's popular Bloody Mary, but we are also serving plenty of Aperol Spritz and Rachel's new favourite for 2023, White Port and Tonic, re-discovered on a cheeky weekend trip to Porto.

**Gin**, of course, there are many, but we have been selective to bring you the best, the most interesting and the most local. **Edinburgh Gin**, **Pilgrim's** and *Isle of Harris* are three of our favourites. (The **Pilgrim's Bramble** is also great as an accompaniment to our cheese board). Our growing rum selection is led by the bar teams' favourite, **Reaper's Rum**. Naturally we have whisky (no 'e' in the Scottish version) from all five of the malt regions, and a few others from Ireland, Tennessee and further afield.

Choose an old favourite or try something new; ask the bar staff to recommend something from Scotland; or just take a chance. Enjoy it (in moderation, of course), enjoy the company, and enjoy The Ship Inn.

## Malt Whisky

### Highland

Glengoyne 18 43% £12.00

A rich and luxurious Highland single malt that has been matured in a mix of refill sherry casks and a generous portion of first-fill sherry casks. The nose has a medley of fruity flavours with fresh bananas, ripe melon and red apples.

**Old Puteney 12** 40% £3.80

Produced in the most northern distillery in Scotland, this whisky combines a flavour of sherry with sweet citrus fruit notes and even a slight hint of brine.

**Glenmorangie** 40.0% £4.50

This whisky fuses a honeyed sweetness with notes of citrus, vanilla and almonds, to create a delicate, but satisfying flavour.

Glengoyne 10 40.0% £4.50

Tasting of a combination of green apples, toffee and a hint of nuttiness, this is one of the only Scottish whiskies to be distilled from completely unpeated malt.

**Aberfeldy 12** 40.0% £4.75

A fruity, clean malt with a touch of honey and spice, to create a smooth, sweet finish.

Loch Lomond Inchmurrin 46.0% £4.50 Marrying together whisky aged in bourbon, refill, and recharred casks, this 12 Year Old expression from

Loch Lomond Distillery is a sweet and fruity Highland Single Malt.

Loch Lomond 12 46.0% £5.00

created using a combination of spirit from a traditional swan neck pot still and a unique straight neck pot still to create an unconventional peat character.

Loch Lomond 18 46.0% £11.00

After spending 18 years maturing in oak, this expression has developed a complex flavour profile featuring red berries, mature oak, vegetal peat and runny honey.

**Old Puteney 18** 46.0% £13.00

Taking its character and colour entirely from the casks within which it has been nurtured, this is a deeply warming whisky. The indulgence extends through this single malt with chocolate and spice defining the character.

### Speyside

Aberlour 12 40.0% £5.00

Golden amber with hints of ruby. And that is true. It looks like a deep auburn syrup, and when swilled in the glass, has a delicious thick appearance.

**Singleton 12** 40.0% £5.20

Sweet and fruity on the nose with a slight woodiness and a hint of lime. A delicate & light malt.

**Cragganmore 12** 46.0% £6.75

Fragrant with sweetish, cider notes & a smoky, peat maltiness in the finish.

**Knockando 12** 43.0% £4.50

The distillery of Knockando translates from Gaelic to "little black hill", and produces a whisky that is soft, light and sweet with a hint of berries.

Tamdhu 12 43.0% £4.75

Deep dark golden. Aroma is classic refill sherry cask - spicy ginger and some waxy apple up front, some borderline chlorine but then figs and saturated dark wood, a little chocolatey later on, candy cane starts to become prominent. Honey hand wash after a few sips.

Cardhu 12 40.0% £4.50

Easy-going, charming Speysider. With clean, crisp oak and sweet malt evoking flavours of honeyed flapjacks and home-made caramel squares.

**Dalwhinnie 15** 43.0% £4.75

Elegant, smooth and medium-bodied, with a light, fruity palate and a whiff of heather on the finish.

**Craigellachie 17** 46.0% £9.50

Released for the first time in 2014. The distillery is known for its meaty character, and the 17-year-old is sweet and slightly smoky, with tropical fruit notes.

**Glenfarclas 15** 46.0% £8.75

Rich and sherried, aged for a little bit longer and bottled a little stronger for a more concentrated, richer flavour.

#### Island

**Highland Park 12** 40.0% £4.75

With a delicious sweetness (heather-honey is their preferred description) and a warming, silky From Orkney.

Talisker 10 45.8% f5.50

A classic Island dram from the Isle of Skye. Always highly rated, lots of spice and fresh, tangy peat.

Jura 10 43.0% £4.50

A union of two Jura malt whisky styles: one bold, strong and peated, the other warm and delicate.

#### Islay

Smokehead 43.0% £5.00

A heavily-peated Islay single malt, hits you like a cannonball and takes you on an explosive rollercoaster of peat, smoke and spice with a little delicate sweetness thrown in.

Bowmore 12 40.0% £4.50

Lemon and honey bouquet with the distinctive Bowmore smokiness. Warm and delicious on the palate with subtle dark chocolate flavours.

**Laphroaig 10** 40.0% £5.15

Full-bodied, smoky gem, with a residual sweetness and a hint of salt amid the seaweedy, peaty characters before a long warming finish. A classic dram.

**Bunnahabhain 12** 46.3% £4.75

Lightly peated for an Islay single malt and consequently is a light, fresh dram. Now at the higher strength - for more complexity and flavour.

Ardbeq 10 46.0% £5.00

A burst of intense smoky fruit escapes into the atmosphere-peat infused with zesty lemon and lime, wrapped in waxy dark chocolate.

Bruichladdich Classic Laddie 50.0% £5.25

Unpeated and elegantly sweet with honeyed barley, boiled sweets and orange petals. Wafts of sea air.

**Caol lla 12** 43.0% £5.75

Of medium weight, but still packing plenty of potent phenols, this is a refined, powerful dram with a compensating oiliness. A balanced, peaty beauty.

Kilchoman Machir Bay 46.0% £5.00

Classic smoky islay single malt on the surface however when tasted a complex balance of peat, vanilla, tropical fruit and intense sweetness combine for a truly unique Islay dram.

**Lagavulin 16** 43.0% £10.50

Massive peat-smoke that's typical of southern Islay - but also offering richness and a dryness that turns it into a truly interesting dram.

#### Campbeltown / Lowland

**Glenkinchie 12** 43.0% £5.50

Sweet, soft start that becomes flowery. It then turns crisp mid-palate, with a herbal and dry finish.

Auchentoshan Three Wood 43.0% £5.20

Matured initially in bourbon casks before being finished in Oloroso then Pedro Ximénez casks for an extra layer of rich, sweet fruitiness.

Glen Scotia 11 54.1% £5.00

Matured in a combination of oloroso and Pedro Ximenez sherry casks. The nose offers notes of toffee, ripe plums and spices, complemented by notes of vanilla.

**Glen Scotia 15** 46.0% £8.75

Gently matured for at least 15 years in hand-selected American oak barrels to deliver the true character of a Campbeltown malt whisky.

Glen Scotia Double Cask 46.0% £5.00

Matured in oak barrels then finished in a combination of American Oak barrels followed by time in Pedro Ximenez sherry casks.

**Kingsbarns** 46.0% £4.75

Dream to dram. The distillery character of Kingsbarns can be described as fruity, light and complex. So far, there is one single malt bottling from Kingsbarns.

**Weymss - The Hive** 46% £3.75

The Hive is based around a signature malt from Speyside blended with at least 16 others from the Highlands, Lowlands and Islay. As with other whiskies in Wemyss' blended malt range, The Hive's name was chosen to reflect the character of the liquid – waxy, sweet and honeyed.

Weymss - The King 46% £3.60

A rich full bodied flavor spicy top notes and a touch of vanilla. Tasting on the nose is complex yet not overwhelming. Lovely, mild on the tongue with a slight burn at the end.
